The trial site is located northwest of the IL176 and US14 intersection on Ridgefield Road in Crystal Lake. From IL176, turn north onto US14, and bear to the right onto Ridgefield Road.

From the North:

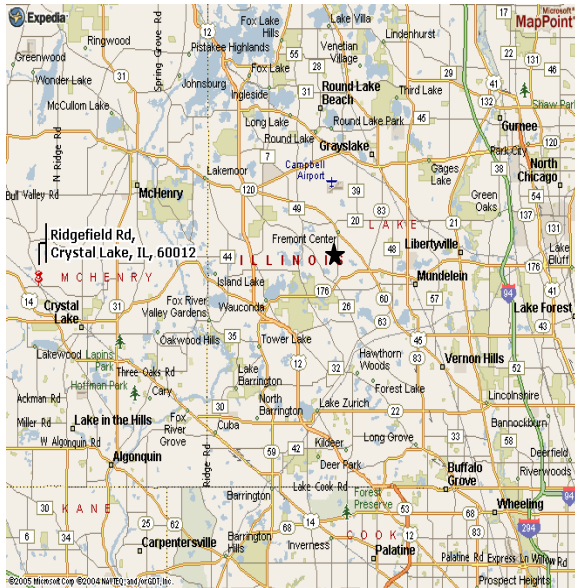
Take I94/I294 to Route 137 (Buckley Rd). Turn south on Route 21 to IL176, turn west on IL176 to Crystal Lake. Follow directions above.

From the South:

Take I94/I294 to IL176 west. West on IL176 to Crystal Lake. Follow directions above.

From the West:

I90 East to Route 31 north. Route 31 north IL176 west. Follow directions above.



Height Cards & Height Measurements: When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Obstacles: Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the *Regulations for AKC Agility Trials*.

Height Divisions: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the regular classes, dogs may run in a higher height division but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred Classes **MUST** jump in their proper height class. Heights are:

Regular (in inches)	Preferred (in inches)	For dogs measuring:
8	4	Preferred dogs 11 inches and under at the withers
12	8	For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
16	12	For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
20	16	For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
24 or 26	20	For dogs over 22 inches at the withers

Prizes and Awards: Rosettes will be awarded to the first through fourth place in each class and height division. Dogs earning qualifying scores will receive an appropriate color qualifying rosette. A MACH rosette and bar will be awarded for teams earning their MACH, at any of these trials — so PLEASE let us know, in advance, if there is a chance of your team earning a MACH at our trial! A PAX rosette will be awarded for teams earning their PAX. All prizes and awards must be claimed the day of the trial — none will be shipped.

Dogs Eligible to Enter: This trial is open to all dogs 15 months or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, have an ILP or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind, or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Vendors: Vendors are WELCOME! Those interested in vending at the show should call the Regional Soccer Center, at 815-455-6634, directly.

Food: Due to venue restrictions, no food or drink, except for your dog(s), may be brought into the site. Food will be available on site through the concession and nearby restaurants.

Notice to Exhibitors

Northwest Obedience Club, Inc. and their Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for a wrong entry. Exhibitors are advised to print when filling in entry forms. **No dog** wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class after the closing of entries, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules and Regulations. No entry may be changed or canceled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date and time for entries. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class. Owners are responsible for errors in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such error. A service fee of \$20 will be charged for correcting secretarial errors not corrected before the day of the trial.

- 1 **Incomplete or illegible entries will be considered invalid entries and shall be returned without prior notification.**
- 2 **Entries will not be accepted without proper fees and signatures. Entries must be submitted on approved entry forms with the agreement printed on the reverse side.** Photocopies of front & back will be accepted if legible.
- 3 Entries returned for non-sufficient funds will be charged a \$40 administration fee.
- 4 A maximum of ten entries per envelope is allowed. Envelopes/transactions with more than the ten dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender. No hand deliveries will be accepted for the first 24 hours after opening date and time.
- 5 Entry fees will not be returned after the closing date for any reason with the following exception: Bitches who come in season after the closing date may have their entry fee returned, less the \$10.00 per day administrative fee, by presenting a veterinarian certificate, on the veterinarian's letterhead, to the Trial Secretary by 7:30a.m. on Friday, Saturday and Sunday, the day of the Trial.
- 6 No entry fees will be returned if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, strikes or any other causes beyond the control of Northwest Obedience Club, Inc.
- 7 Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from the competition by the action of vet, judge, or Trial Committee.
- 8 Dogs are not required to be at the trial site until the scheduled time of judging. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler is solely responsible for having the dog measured and ready at ringside when the class is to be judged.
- 9 **The safety of the dogs is our primary concern.** By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- 10 ***Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.***
- 11 Illinois State law requires proof of Rabies vaccinations (a Rabies tag) as well as a health certificate —which was signed by your veterinarian within 30 days of use.
- 12 **It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children.** Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- 13 **Please assist us in keeping this show site clean by cleaning up after your dog and yourself. Anyone caught not cleaning up after his or her dog or oneself will be asked to leave.**
- 14 **All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in designated agility warm-up areas. No open flexi's will be allowed in the building.**
